The present Grant Co-operation Agreement between the two parties relates to the implementation of the Project **"Monitoring and assessment of the impact of droughts on water resources and their effective use in Georgia"** financed by the SlovakAid – Official Development Assistance of the Slovak Republic under the Contract No. SAMRS/2016/VP/01/06.

1. **National Environmental Agency (Georgia)** agrees to participate in the project as the Partner of the Contractor.
2. **Project duration:** 01.01.2017 – 30.06.2018. The present Grant Co-operation Agreement comes into force after contract between SAMRS and SHMU is valid.
3. The total amount of financial allocation available from the SlovakAid program to the Partner of the Contractor will be **EUR 20 070,00 (in words: Twenty thousand seventy). This amount will consist from the following items:**

Project manager: 3 330,00 EUR

Experts fees: 16 200,00 EUR

Overheads: 540,00 EUR

4. The Partner of the Contractor will provide the following services: expertise. Based on this agreement, Partner of the Contractor will provide the Contractor with invoices supported by necessary accounting documents (i.e. order of services, invoice from the service provider and payment made by the partner to project manager and experts (see Annex 1), based on the timesheets (see Annex 2).
5. In case the service mentioned in article 4 will require more funding than estimated, the Partner of the Contractor agrees to cover all necessary expenses in order to allow for completion of "the outcomes of the project".
6. The Partner of the Contractor confirms and agrees to permit the monitors and evaluators on behalf of the Slovak Agency for International Development Cooperation to access the documentation related to the project implementation and to provide them with assistance in reviewing the project progress, results and impact at the place of implementation.
7. The content of the information materials developed, distributed and covered by the SlovakAid expenses has to be in line with the Project objectives. Consultation and approval of the materials by the representatives of the Slovak Agency for International Development Cooperation prior to the publication and distribution is obligatory.
8. The Partner of the Contractor agrees to submit to the Contractor report on the activities (content and financial disbursements) according to requirements articulated by the Contractor.
9. The Contractor and its Partner are obliged to respect the Implementation Plan (see Annex 3), the time schedule and budget lines and to inform each other on all circumstances which can cause any significant deviation and/or jeopardise the project objectives and outputs.
