2. Timetable

Timing	Activity/Session/Task
Day 1 - 9:00 - 12:00	Introduction - Arriving at school, introduction of pupils and teachers, going into a classroom, introduction of the school and the school system – comparing to the Slovak one.
Day 2 - 9:00 - 12:00	Visit a village in order to get a culture and taste traditional cuisine. The students will also visit a monastery which is included in the UNESCO World Heritage. A short presentation in the village about the procedure of making traditional dry bread with tasting.
Day 3 – 9:00 – 12:00	Discussion on Human Rights – Visit the Human Rights sculpture park located at the school and have an interactive discussion on Human Rights, comparing the both countries, what are the most important issues about Human Rights. The

	students will collaborate to produce a poster to be displayed at both schools.
Day 4 – 9:00 – 20:00	Culture - Experiencing the Cypriot folklore – music and dancing – comparing to the Slovak folklore. The teachers involved will present different dances in a quiz manner and a group of dancers will dance traditional dances and invite students to try. Similarly with the music teacher.
Day 5 – 9:00 – 12:00	Environment – Participate in a hands on environmental program, coordinated by the Ministry of Education to talk about different issues related to how

3. Learning programme

Activity 1: Introduction	
Learning methods:	Learning will be organised in a classroom. Pupils of hosting organisation will introduce their school, school system and their country by using presentations and other interactive digital tools. Most learning methods will be presentations, discussions and comparison. Slovak pupils will also present our school in order to compare different systems of education. There will be a tour around the school, Slovak pupils will attend some lessons, e.g. English and possibly other subjects taught in English.
Learning outcomes:	Pupils will learn about different educational systems, new facts about the country/countries. They will improve their language, presentation, digital and social skills and competencies.

Activity 2: Culture and UNESCO World Heritage	
Learning methods:	Students will visit a village to witness the traditional architecture and cuisine. The will visit places which make traditional products as well as a monastery which has relics of inestimable religious values for the Cypriots.
Learning outcomes:	Students will learn about the local culture and cuisine by interacting with the locals. They will improve their language, presentation and social skills and competencies.

Activity 3: Discussion on Human Rights	
Learning methods:	By visiting the park dedicated to Human Rights, we will discuss the topic from different points of view (e.g. human rights and women, children elderly people, immigrants etc.) As UNESCO associated member schools, it is necessary to discuss one of the core values of UNESCO philosophy.
Learning outcomes:	Discussions on human rights, what is important in both countries, how this topic is seen from different points of view. Communication skills will be improved. The main methods will be a comparison and a discussion. They will improve their language, presentation and social skills and competencies.

Activity 4: Traditional folklore	
Learning methods:	A typical music, musical instruments and dancing will be presented (live or via videos/records) which will be compared to the Slovak ones.
Learning outcomes:	Pupils will learn about Cypriot music and dances, the way they developed over the years, and their cultural significance. They will develop their multicultural competencies, social and communicative skills.

Activity 5: Working on a project	
Learning methods:	Pupils will discuss the main environmental problems in Cyprus, sustainability (which is also one of the UNESCO value), recycling/reusing etc. The environmental issues can be the topic for our next project.
Learning outcomes:	Pupils will learn more about ecology in Cyprus, how environmental problems are solved on the island. The main methods will be presentations and discussions, hence digital, citizenship, social and language competencies will be developed.
