1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this grant is to enable the grantee in inviting a guest of Opera SND Mr. Paul Mauffray, US conductor who will rehearse during June and October with the orchestra, choir and the soloists of the Slovak National Theatre – Opera and will premiere Maria Theresia opera project in October 2012.

2. BUDGET

6. TERMINATION BY MUTUAL AGREEMENT

The PAO or the Recipient may wish to terminate its performance of this project in whole or in part. If both parties agree that continuation of the project would not produce results commensurate with further expenditure of funds or for any other reason, the Grant Agreement may be terminated by mutual consent. This must be done in writing. The PAO shall allow full credit to the Recipient of the amount incurred prior to termination that can not be cancelled properly by the Recipient.

7. SUSPENSION OR TERMINATION FOR CAUSE

- (a) When the recipient has materially failed to comply with the terms and program objectives of this grant, the PAS may:
 - 1) Suspend the Agreement in whole or in part; or
 - 2) Terminate the Agreement in whole or in part for cause.
- (b) The PAO may issue notification letter to the Recipient of its intent to suspend or terminate this Agreement. The Recipient has 10 calendar days to respond in writing describing the action taken or the plan designed to correct the deficiency. If satisfactory action is not taken or there



is no response, the PAO may suspend or terminate the agreement effective as determined by the PAO. Payments to the Recipient or recoveries made by the PAS shall be in accordance with the legal rights and remedies of the parties.

8. PROGRAM PROPERTY

The PAO reserves the right to require transfer property acquired with assistance funds and used during the program to the Recipient.
